



Q. WHERE IS THE OUTDOOR CINEMA?

A. Barton Rovers Football Club, Sharpenhoe Road, Barton Le-Clay, MK45 4LQ

Q. HOW WILL YOU COMPLY WITH COVID-19 REGULATIONS?

A. KidsOut and CHUMS have made the safety of our attendees our number one priority and want to make our events as safe as possible whilst raising vital funds for our services. Each group will be given a 2m x 2m square with a 1m distance between each spot. There will be a one-way entrance in to the seating area, toilets, and venders.

Toilets will be regularly cleaned.

Whilst we do have these measures in place, we ask you to be kind and considerate to other guests and rules put in place by the Government. Please feel free to bring your own PPE equipment.

Q. WILL THE SCREEN STILL BE VISIBLE DURING THE DAY?

A. Ellievision have a large range of outdoor LED screens which provide a far superior viewing quality and experience than standard projection solutions.

Their open air screens use the latest hi-resolution technology allowing for the best picture quality in bright sunlight or bad weather screenings.

Q. WHAT IF IT RAINS?

A. The event will still go ahead so please check the forecast before attending. Shows will only be cancelled if weather warnings are issued and could present danger to our customers. KidsOut & CHUMS will alert you of any cancelations as soon as possible, but no later than 6 hours before the screening. Refunds are only permitted if the show has to be cancelled.

Q. HOW WILL I RECEIVE MY TICKET?

A. You will receive an email confirmation which you must bring on the day. Upon arriving please ensure you have this ready to show the steward.

Q. WHAT TIME SHOULD I ARRIVE?

A. We recommend arriving 45-60 minutes before the show starts. Please leave extra time if you wish to get food and drink as there will be a one-way system in place for your safety.

Shows start at 2pm and 6.30pm.

There is no admission once the film has started and refunds will not be provided to latecomers.

Q. WILL THERE BE PARKING?

A. Chargeable parking is available for a fee of £5 and must be pre-booked before the event. Upon arriving please ensure you have this ready to show the steward. There are 7 disabled parking spaces available on a first come first serve basis and must be pre-booked with a valid blue badge clearly displayed.

Q. IS THERE DISABLED ACCESS?

A. Yes there is disabled access on to the pitch.

Q. CAN I SMOKE?

A. Smoking is not permitted.

Q. WILL THERE BE FOOD?

A. A selection of local food vendors will be serving, and soft/alcoholic drinks will be available from the Barton Rovers bar.

You are welcome to bring your own food and drink (drinks **MUST** be in plastic bottle/cups) in to the venue, however we do encourage you to support your local businesses during these times.

Rubbish bins will be provided but we also ask you to be considerate of the grounds and pick up your rubbish or take it home.

Q. WILL THERE BE TOILETS AT THE FACILITY?

A. Portaloo's will be available at the back of the venue. Please ensure to stay 2 metres away from other guests if there is a queue, and we encourage you to wear a face mask.

Q. CAN I BRING MY OWN CHAIRS?

A. Please bring your own chairs and blankets. If you are bringing chairs, we do ask you to be considerate of other guests around you.

Q. CAN I BRING MY DOG?

A. Unfortunately, dogs are not allowed on site apart from registered service animals.

Q. WILL THERE BE SUBTITLES OR AUDIO DESCRIPTION?

A. We do not have any audio described or subtitled screenings.
